## The Updated Fire Alarm Grades

Grade F1: The system consists of one or more tamper-proof battery-powered detectors. Grade F2: The fire alarm system has one or more detectors that run on user-replaceable primary batteries.



### Grade F1

A system consisting of one or more battery-powered detectors powered by one or more tamper-resistant primary batteries.



### Grade F2

A system of one or more battery-powered detectors whose primary battery or batteries are user-replaceable.




### LD1 – HIGH PROTECTION

- Meter Cupboards




### LD2 – MEDIUM PROTECTION

Escape routes and high risk areas

Examples:

- Hallways
- Landings
- Living Rooms
- Kitchens



### LD3 – MINIMUM PROTECTION

Escape routes
